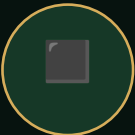

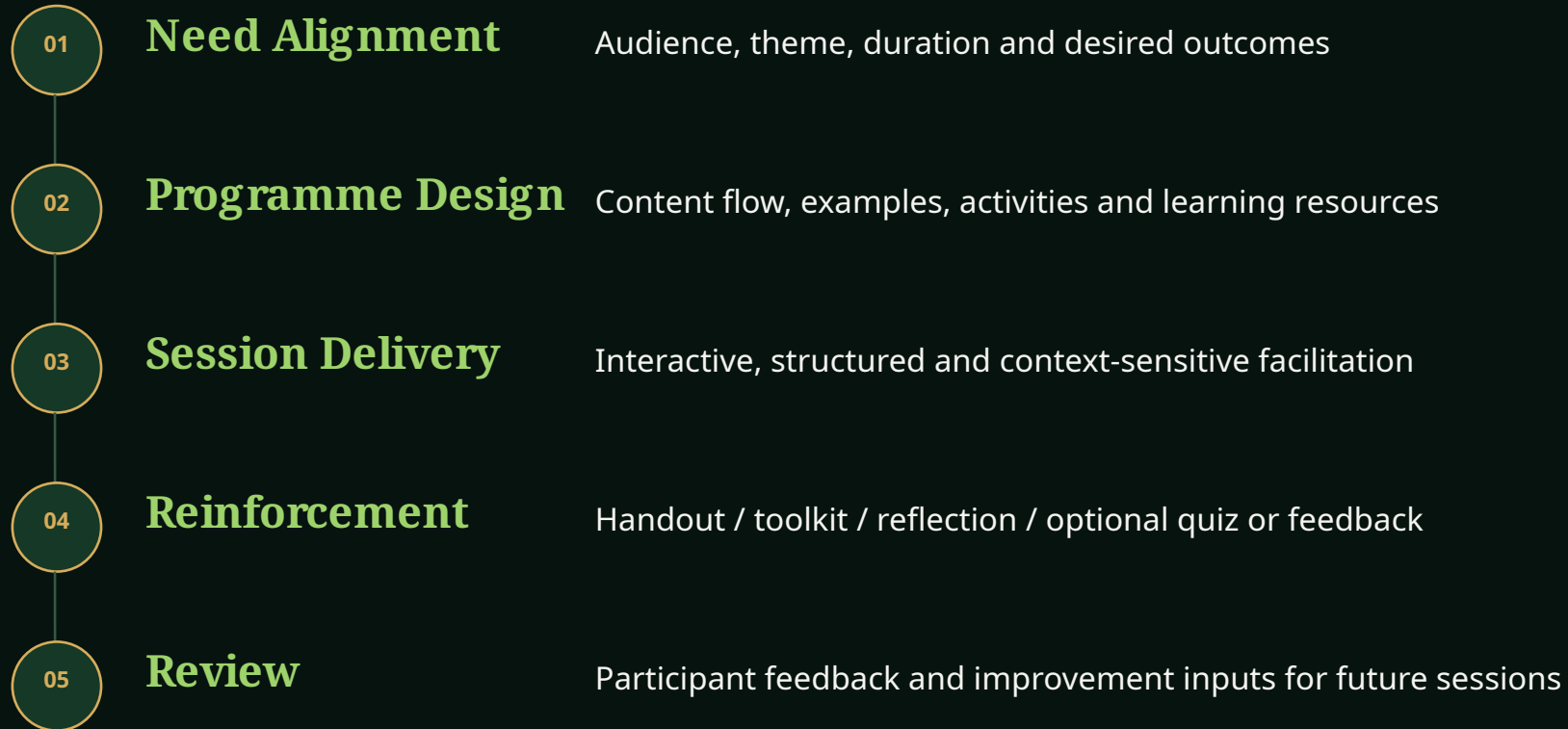

4

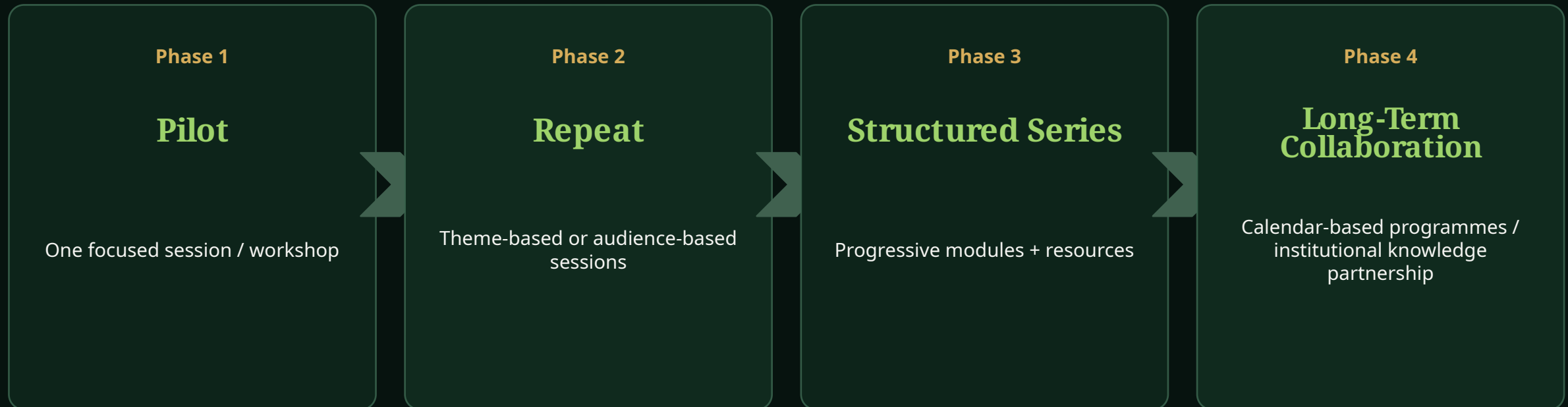
Reflect
